Csaba Csaki

Csaba Csaki is the head of the Department of Agricultural Economics at the Corvinus University in Budapest, where he served from 1979 to 1985 as Dean of Production Economics and from 1985 to 1991 as Rector (Corvinus University was at that time the Karl Marx University of Economics). He is currently serving as a member of the Board of Governors of the Hungarian Central Bank. Csaba has been involved over the years, under different forms, with Iowa State University, University of California, Davis, FAO, the International Institute for Applied Systems Analysis (IIASA) and the World Bank. Csaba served on the Board of the EAAE for nine years and was elected Vice President of our Association for the 1984-87 term. He has been member of the Board of IAAE for 9 years and served as President of that Association for the period 1991-94. He is the author or co-author of numerous monographs and books and he is recognized as a leading world expert on comparative analysis of the agricultural transformation that countries in transition have undergone during the last one and a half decade. He received honorary doctorates from DePaul University (USA), Ghent University (Belgium) and Szent Istvan University (Hungary). A strong advocate of East-West exchanges, Csaba has been probably the most outstanding and effective bridge-builder between the East European agricultural economists and those in Western Europe and overseas.
