His research focuses on agricultural policy as well as international trade and trade negotiations issues.

What is unique about Jean-Christophe is his sharp vision of agricultural economics and trade issues. His independent thinking combined with an in-depth knowledge of agricultural, international, and public economics and a thorough understanding of the policymaking process. He is the author of more than 60 peer-reviewed articles, an important fraction of them in top journals in the field such as the American Journal of Agricultural Economics and the European Review of Agricultural Economics. His strong publication record places him among the top-5%
