While being internationally very active and a guest lecturer at many universities, he was his entire professional career based in CITA



(Agrofood Research and Technological Centre of Aragon), where he is currently the Chairman of the Scientific Committee.

He organized the first Congress of the Spanish Association of Agricultural Economists in 1992, was a leading professional in the governance of the association for many years and was Chief Editor of the most prestigious Spanish Agricultural Economics Journal during 12 years.

Then he moved on to the European level, and made many important contributions to the EAAE:

- He organized the 1st (!!!) and the 34th Seminar of the Association, both held in Zaragoza (Spain).
- Chairman of the Local Organising Committee of the X Congress held in Zaragoza (Spain), in 2002.
- Chairman of the Scientific Committee of the XII Congress held in Copenhagen (Denmark), in 2008.
- Member of the Executive Board of the Association during 6 years.
- Member of the Editorial Board of the European Review of Agricultural Economics during 7 years (in addition to being on several other editorial boards).

He was the Scientific director of the Agro -food Marketing area at the Agronomic Mediterranean Institute of Zaragoza (IAMZ) for more than thirty years as part of the CIHEAM system.

He has been tutor of master and PhD theses of more than 20 foreign students from Latin America and Mediterranean countries. He published in numerous journals and held invited lecturers in many universities , especially in Southern Europe , North Africa and Latin America.

Dr Albisu deserves the recognition of being appointed Fellow of the EAAE for his lifetime dedication to the profession in Spain, in Latin America, the EU and the Mediterranean region.
