NON-EAAE SEMINARS, WORKSHOPS AND CONGRESSES

FAO/WHO GIFT releases statistics and infographics on the environmental impacts of individual food consumption to support informed decision-making for healthy diets from sustainable food systems.

FAO/WHO Global Individual Food Consumption Data Tool (https://www.fao.org/gift-individual-food-consumption/en/) is an innovative, open-access tool, which supports stakeholders to access data on what and how much people eat and drink. The platform is a growing data repository that leverages existing quantitative dietary intake data at an individual level to support informed decision making and improve national and subnational food and nutrition policies. FAO/WHO GIFT allows users to download data for free and provides statistics and infographics based on this data which can be used for multiple purposes, including for nutrition and food safety.

Recently, FAO/WHO GIFT was enhanced to include new statistics and infographics on the environmental impacts of diets. Incorporating planetary health considerations into dietary assessment is crucial to promote healthy diets from sustainable agri-food systems. The purpose of the infographics is to illustrate the estimated impact of diets on the environment using real individual-level quantitative dietary intake data.

The new infographics provide estimates of the greenhouse gas emissions, water use and land use associated with diets in two different ways: (a) estimated environmental impacts per person per day, broken down by food groups, subgroups and items; (b) estimated environmental impacts per 1000 kilocalories, 10 g of protein or 100 mg of calcium, per person per day. Average environmental impacts are presented, together with hypothetical scenarios showing lower or higher environmental impacts.

FAO/WHO GIFT aims to improve the availability and access to individual-level quantitative dietary intake data for policy makers, researchers and program planners to enable them to use existing data and evidence about what people eat and drink. By presenting information on the environmental impacts of dietary intake, FAO/WHO GIFT will offer evidence to support informed decisions on actions, interventions, and policies for sustainable and healthy diets for people and the planet.

- We have been informed by Scopus that they have accepted Q Open for indexing. This is an important first step in being included in the major indexes and achieving an impact factor.

- Q Open is also well on track to reach key-performance indicators on growth in the number of manuscripts and in the turn-around time for review.
