Q Open is looking for new Associate Editors

The European Agricultural and Applied Economics Publications Foundation is seeking to appoint several new Associate Editors for Q OPEN for the period beginning April 2026 (or as soon as possible thereafter). The new appointments replace several existing Associate Editors, who are stepping down after 4 years of service. Candidates should have an extensive knowledge of the

relevant agricultural and/or environmental/resource economics literatures. They should have an excellent publishing record and proven reviewing expertise. Experience as a member of the Editorial Board of a scientific journal is an advantage. A vision regarding the position and development of Q OPEN should accompany these scholarly requirements. Ability to work in a team and to manage deadlines effectively is required. Q Open is seeking Associate Editors with the following profiles:

- a. Production / efficiency / farm economics
- b. Development economics
- c. Agro-economic models
- d. Trade and markets

ERAE Review Articles

In addition to research articles, the journal also publishes review articles. Review articles should provide a comprehensive and scholarly account of a topic that has direct relevance to agricultural economics (methodological or applied) and that has not recently been covered in the literature. Normally these are authored by individuals who have themselves made a significant contribution to the topic under review and/or are acknowledged authorities in the field. A pre-submission enquiry to is required for review articles. An abstract, outline and key references should be emailed to erae.editorialoffice@theeditorialhub.com. Review article submissions undergo the normal review process.
