Venue

Budapest is a capital city and the most populous city of Hungary. The Budapest Ferenc Liszt International Airport (BUD) is located 16 kilometres east-southeast of the centre of Budapest. For those coming by car or train, all of the major highways and railways end within the city limits.

The Corvinus University of Budapest (and in particular the agricultural economics unit) already has some experience in organising events with the European Association of Agricultural Economists. In 1987, the Department was responsible for organising the 5th EAAE Congress at Balatonszeplak, the joint IAAE-104th EAAE Seminar in 2007, the 142nd EAAE Seminar in 2014 and the 162nd EAAE Seminar in 2018 in Budapest at the University premises.

The Corvinus University of Budapest has basically two different buildings to host such events.

Budapest can offer a wide variety of hotels located mainly in the city centre with affordable prices. There are many hotels near the University in different price categories, so the workshop location is easily accessible. LOC will recommend nearby hotels.

Scientific program and themes

The workshop welcomes PhD students at any stage of their PhD, as well as students who just completed their PhD at the time of the workshop. Both scientific program and themes will be defined in more details in the next months by the Scientific Committee. A preliminary list of topics would include:

Submission types

The workshop accepts two different types of submissions.

In the “finished papers” submission, students present the papers that have been selected for this format (20 minutes for each presentation), and the discussion will be opened by a discussant (10 minutes for each paper) - papers will be distributed in advance. This a ”classic type” of full paper submission considered by most conferences.

In the “paper proposals” submissions, the time allocated for each presentation and discussion is 15 minutes. These types of submissions include a broad idea and basic research concept, presented in 5 minutes, followed by a 10 minutes discussion.
